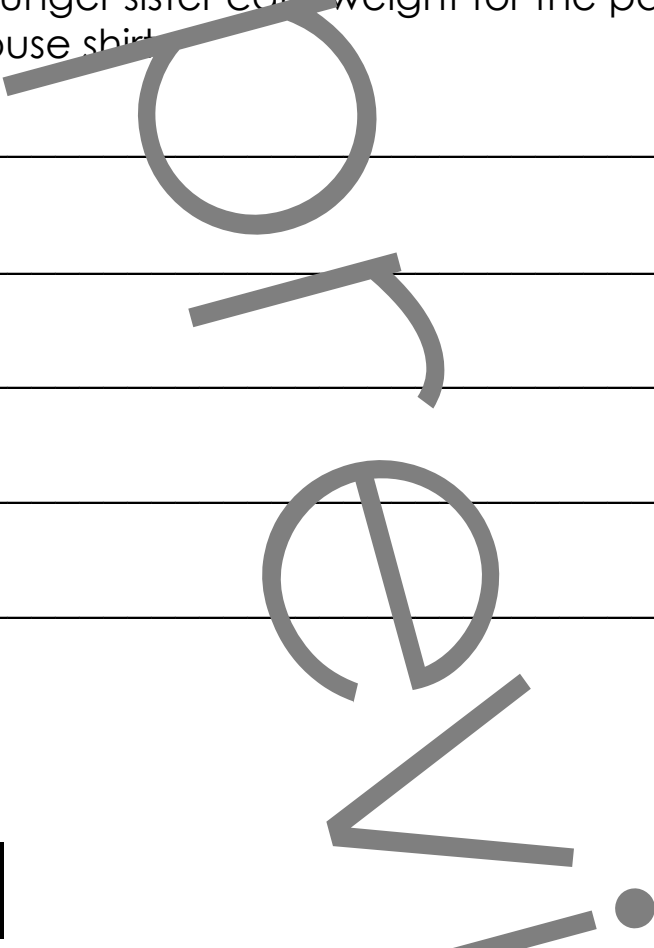

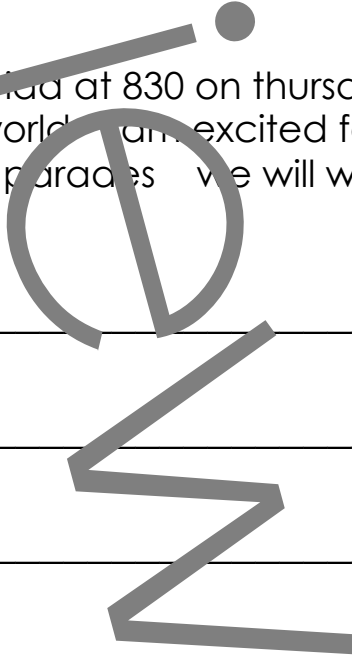

Give students a couple of weeks of a grace period when it comes to DOL scores.
