Hi Teacher! Thank you for downloading this DOL booklet for your students! Quick, repetitive, daily sentence correction is a powerful way to influence and impact student writing. Your students are going to benefit from this routine practice!

OVERVIEW

These DOL booklets are divided into 8 weeks chunks. They are designed to grow WITH your students. In Books 1 & 2, students will correct 3 sentences at a time. In Book 3, students will also correct a paragraph on Fridays (or every 5th day). In Books 4 & 5, students will complete a short language activity (on Thursdays or every 4th day), and correct a short paragraph (on Fridays or every 5th day.)

BOOKLET VERSIONS

In this file, the booklets come in 2 versions:

- Half-page booklets labeled by day of the week (Week 1, Monday)
- Half-page booklets labeled by number (Day 1, Day 2)

In the *other file that is zipped with this one*, are 2 more versions:

- Whole-page booklets labeled by day of the week (Week 1, Monday)
- Whole-page booklets labeled by number (Day 1, Day 2)

The numbered version is most helpful for people who don't do DOL everyday. The day of the week version is most useful for those who make this a daily routine. Other than the labeling, the pages are exactly the same!

CREATING THE BOOKLETS

For the half-page version, just print, stack, and cut down the center! Booklets work best stapled once in the corner.

For the whole-page version, just print and staple. Booklets can be stapled once in the corner or 3 times down the left side to create a "spine."
