# Help! A Story of Friendship



### **CONTENTS & EXPLANATION**

Visualizing	Students draw a part of the story they were able to visualize. They describe their visualization in writing.			
Visualizing: Picture Summary	Students draw a picture summary of the story. They use their visualizations of the beginning, middle, and ending to help them.



Spelling Words Writing 3x Each	Students write their spelling words 3 times each.
Vowel Sound Sort	Students sort spelling words based on vowel sound.
Spelling Triangles	Students write their spelling words, building with one letter at time, so that words that shaped as a triangle.






